Tickets on Sale Now: Julie Gerstenblatt on Friday, September 25th

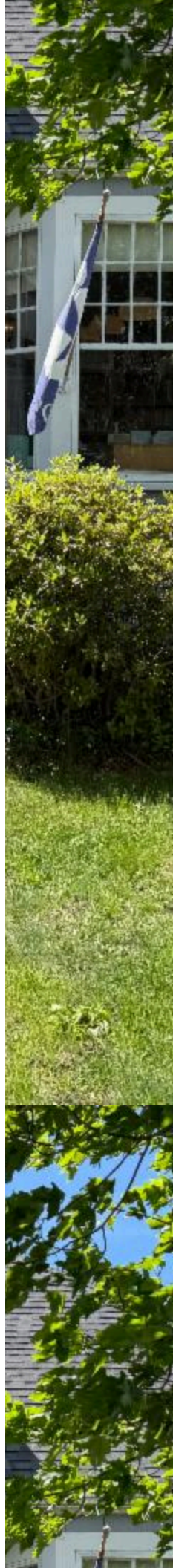

Tickets are \$42 and include light breakfast (muffins, danish, fruit, yogurt, tea & coffee).

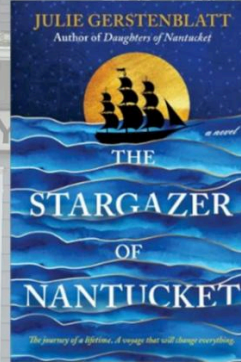

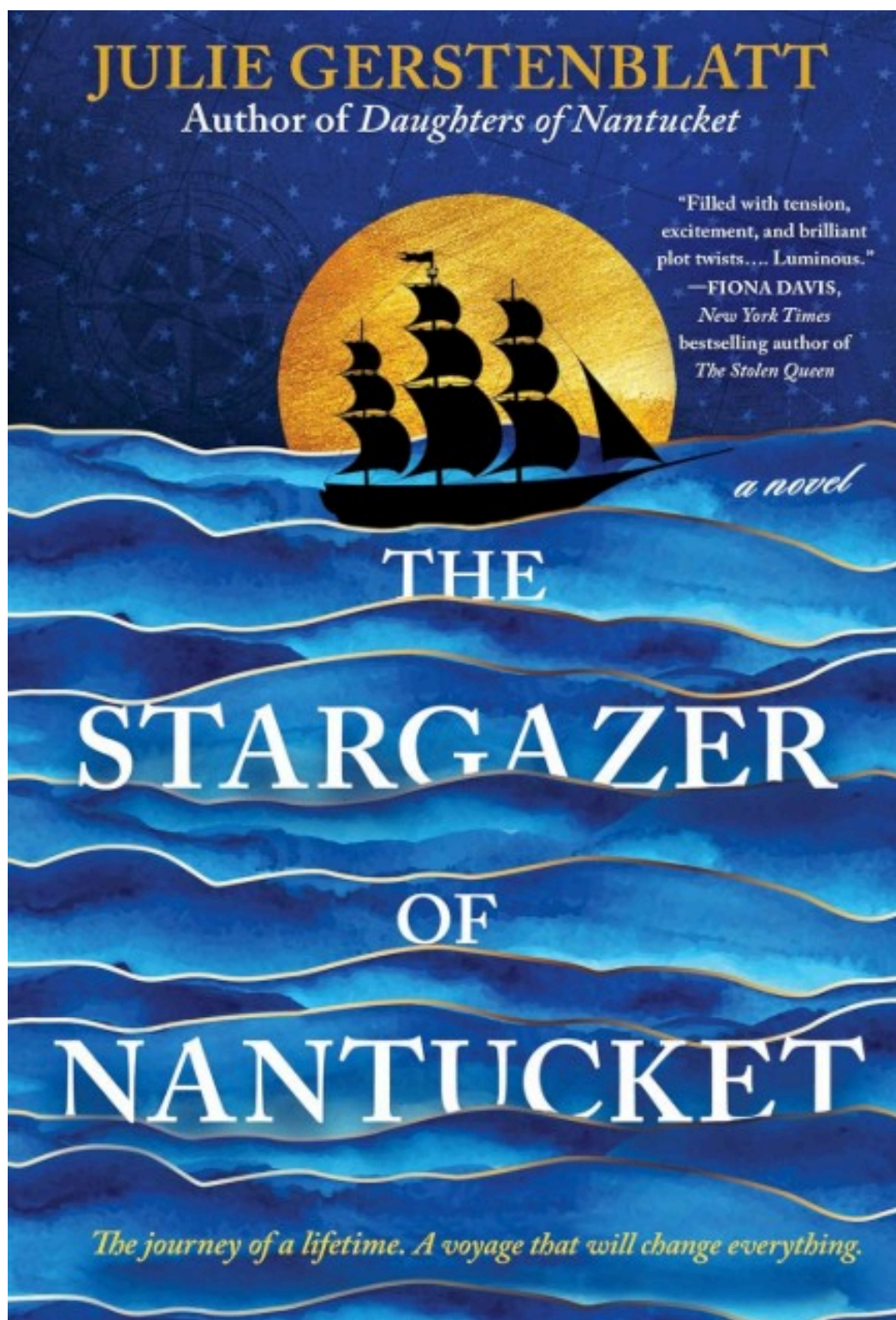

The histories of trees in America are also the histories of Black Americans. Pecan trees were domesticated by an enslaved African named Antoine; sycamore trees were both havens and signposts for people trying to escape enslavement; poplar trees are historically associated with lynching; and willow bark has offered the gift of medicine. In *When Trees Testify*, award-winning plant biologist Beronda L. Montgomery explores the ways seven trees—as well as the cotton shrub—are intertwined with Black history and culture.

High Altitudes and High Stakes: A Miss Marple Mystery with Lucy Foley

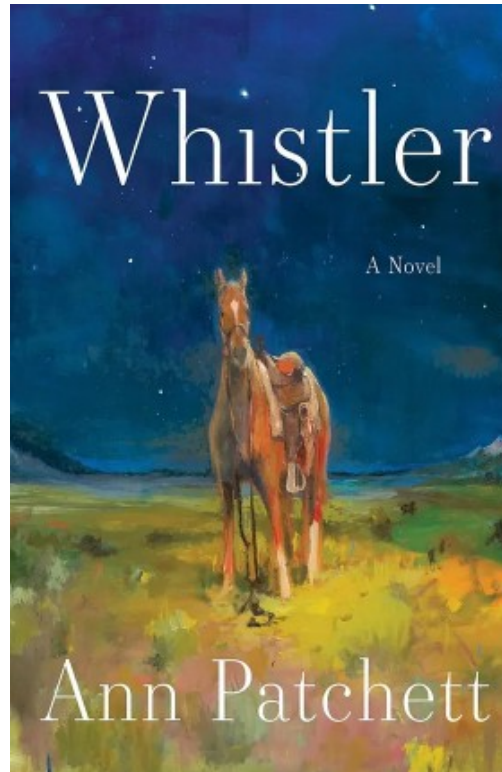
