Julie Gerstenblatt on September 25th

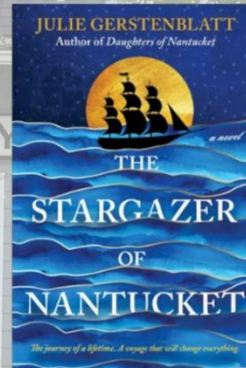
Only a couple more weeks to buy tickets for our talk with award-winning author Julie Gerstenblatt, on Friday, September 25th at The
